Deepak Krishnan is the chief of Oral Maxillofacial surgery both at University of Cincinnati and at Cincinnati Children's hospital and medical center. He is an associate professor of Surgery at the College of Medicine at University of Cincinnati in Ohio, USA, where he teaches and practices.

Deepak obtained his dental degree from Bangalore University, India and trained in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at Emory University's College of Medicine in Atlanta, Georgia. Upon completion of the residency, Deepak pursued further fellowship training in Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery focusing on orthognathic surgery at Dalhousie University, Halifax, Canada.

He currently serves as the chair of the American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons (AAOMS) Committee on Anesthesia (CAN) and serves on the Committee of Education and Training (CET) of the AAOMS as well as the special committee for Academic Mentorship for the AAOMS. He is the secretary and treasurer of the American College of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons (ACOMS).

He is a past-president of the Ohio State Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons and the current president of the Ohio Dental Society of Anesthesiology. He is a senior examiner for the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery (ABOMS). He is a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons (ACS).
