PRESENTATION

Surgery has been the cornerstone of treatment for a variety of ailments affecting the face, mouth and neck for as long it has been a discipline of medicine and dentistry. Though surgical principles, antiseptic techniques and advances in anesthesia have revolutionized the safety and efficacy of surgery in the last century, many fundamentals remain unchanged. Surgeons may often be dogmatic in his or her approach to common problems that patients face and apply known algorithms to a variety of clinical scenarios.

With the advent and validation of personalized tools including biomarkers, point of care 3D printing, regenerative medicine, and patient specific implants, surgeons are able to better tailor treatments to fit each individual and specific clinical scenario.

OBJECTIVES

- How to identify a variety of tissue biomarkers that can be used to tailor oncologic therapy.
